Executive Demographic Summary Report

Population

The current year population in this selected geography is 35,654. The 2000 Census revealed a population of 29,167, and in 1990 it was 18,843 representing a 54.8% change. It is estimated that the population in this area will be 40,948 in 2011, representing a change of 14.8% from 2006. The current population is 49.3% male and 50.7% female. In 2006, the median age of the population in this area was 47.7, compared to the US median age which was 36.5. The population density in your area is 113.5 people per square mile.

Households

There are currently 16,119 households in this selected geography. The Census revealed household counts of 12,518 in 2000, up from 8,021 in 1990, representing a change of 56.1%. It is estimated that the number of households in this area will be 19,232 in 2011, representing a change of 19.3% from the current year. For the current year, the average household size in this area is 2.21 persons.

In 2006, the median number of years in residence in this geography's population is 3.19. The average household size in this geography was 2.19 people and the average family size was 2.60 people. The average number of vehicles per household in this geography was 1.9.

Income

In 2006, the median household income in this selected geography was \$43,671, compared to the US median which was \$48,271. The Census revealed median household incomes of \$38,492 in 2000 and \$24,879 in 1990 representing a change of 54.7%. It is estimated that the median household income in this area will be \$48,043 in 2011, which would represent a change of 10.0% from the current year.

In 2006, the per capita income in this area was \$22,521, compared to the \$US per capita, which was \$24,529. The 2006 average household income for this area was \$50,026, compared to the US average which was \$63,629.

Race & Ethnicity

In 2006, the racial makeup of this selected area was as follows: 94.1% White; 0.2% Black; 1.2% Native American; 0.4% Asian/Pacific Islander; and 1.9% Other. Compare these to the US racial makeup which was: 75.9% White, 12.1% Black, 0.7% Native American, 4.5% Asian/Pacific Islander and 4.5% Other.

People of Hispanic ethnicity are counted independently of race. People of Hispanic origin make up 6.7% of the current year population in this selected area. Compare this to the US makeup of 14.9%. Changes in the population within each race and ethnicity category from the 1990 Census to the 2000 Census are as follows: 50.9% American Indian, Eskimo, Aleut Population; 127.0% Asian, Pacific Islander; 342.5% Black; 1,226.2% Hispanic Ethnicity; 1,627.1% Other; White 49.3%.

Housing

The median housing value in this area was \$63,404 in 1990, compare this to the US median of \$78,382 for the same year. The 2000 Census median housing value was \$101,470, which is a 60.0% change from 1990. In 1990, there were 6,309 owner occupied housing units in this area vs. 10,119 in 2000. Also in 1990, there were 1,712 renter occupied housing units in this area vs. 2,400 in 2000. The average rent in 1990 was \$272 vs. \$445 in 2000.

Employment

In 2006, there were 14,672 people over the age of 16 in the labor force in your geography. Of these 96.4% were employed, 3.5% were unemployed, 50.4% were not in the labor force and 0.1% were in the Armed Forces. In 1990, unemployment in this area was 5.0% and in 2000 it was 3.4%.

In 2006, there were 6,759 employees in this selected area (daytime population) and there were 803 establishments. For this area in 1990, 46.6% of employees were employed in white-collar occupations and 53.5% were employed in blue-collar occupations. In 2000, white collar workers made up 54.4% of the population, and those employed in blue collar occupations made up 45.6%. In 1990, the average time traveled to work was 8 minutes and in 2000 it was 22 minutes.
